STARTING SCHOOL...

We have good arrangements in place to make the transition to school as easy as possible for your child. For example:

- ▶ Pre-school visits by the class teachers
- ▶ New Parents meeting with the school team
- ▶ Visits to the classroom – story time, teddy bear's picnic etc..
- ▶ Sharing of transition documents
- ▶ Letters from staff to children
- ▶ Phased start for first week – half days, stay for lunch then full-time
- ▶ Parents' Meeting at end of Autumn 1
- ▶ Parent workshops

- ▶ The deadline for applications is 15th January 2023, and allocation day will be 17th April 2023.
