School Uniform I am very impressed with how smart the vast majority of children look in their school uniforms. Please continue to do your best to ensure that children wear the correct uniform every day. As a reminder:

- Trainers are **not** suitable school footwear.
- The wearing of jewellery is **not** permitted except **simple small ear studs** and watches.
- For Health & Safety reasons it is essential that no jewellery is worn in P.E. lessons.
- Long hair should be tied back. Hair bobbles/bands should be small and in keeping with school uniform.
- Make- up, including nail varnish should not be worn.
- **Please mark all your child's clothing clearly with their name** this makes it easier to reunite lost items with their owner.
- If your child has a Greenleas fleece can you please check they are wearing the correct one, we currently have a missing one with a child's name on the front.

Now the weather is getting colder can we please request that children bring a coat to school.

Please remember that children should not climb on the Trim Trail equipment, play football or go in the bushes at the beginning or end of the day. No scooters and bikes should be ridden on the school playground at any time. Children remain the responsibility of their parents until they enter the building at 8:55am and once collected at 3:15pm. Could I please ask you to reiterate this to your child so that we are working together to ensure our environment is safe for everyone.
