Christmas Nativity F2 and KS1

Christmas performances by children are always very special events and a staple of a school Christmas. The scripts are ready, the children are rehearsing and the performances will take place next week.

F2 1 performance at 9am on Tuesday 12th December 2023- no ticket needed but limited to two adults per child.

KS1 2 performances on Friday 15th December 9:30am and 2:00pm. <u>Tickets will be needed for entry</u>.

Further information has been sent out to the relevant parents.

At these events, we appreciate that families will want to treasure photographic/video memories, and the general rule is that parents and carers may take photos and videos of the children in their care, for personal use only. Live streaming, whether public or private, cannot be permitted and we request that you do not use any streaming platforms or 'live' features (e.g. Facebook Live) to stream events/circumstances as they occur.

When you capture footage or still images of your children, there is a strong possibility that other children will also be visible or audible. For this reason, no such content should be shared publicly e.g. on social media. There are several important reasons for this:

- Some children are deemed at risk by local authority safeguarding and child protection authorities; their image must never be put online for their own protection. You are very unlikely to know who these children are. Others may have complex family backgrounds which mean that sharing their image could have unforeseen consequence. There is the real possibility you could endanger a child by sharing their image in an identifiable context (e.g. where the school is easy to identify and locate).
- Consent is needed from parents to comply with data protection legislation, which is enhanced under GDPR and the Data Protection Bill.
- Some families may object for religious or cultural reasons, or simply for reasons of personal privacy.
- We encourage young people at our school to think about their online reputation and digital footprint: online photos and videos do not simply disappear when we delete them from our accounts. Help us be good adult role models by not oversharing.

We want you to enjoy school events and activities with your child, so why not just sit back, enjoy the memories and allow others to do so too? Remember, your child wants to see you looking at them, not at your phone. Thanks for your understanding.
