Getting the right school for your child is very important

If your child was born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, they are due to start school in September 2021. You need to make an application for a school place by 15 January 2021. This leaflet will highlight the facts and shows deadlines you must meet.

Essential Information

Most children attend a primary school near their home. Parents have a right to say which school they wish their child to attend and in most cases it is possible to meet these wishes. Each community and voluntary controlled school has it's own catchment zone and uses the same policy for admission of children.

Catholic and Church of England voluntary aided schools serve parishes rather than catchment zones and have their own admission policies. Academy Schools also have their own admission policy. The Local Authority co-ordinates the admissions process to all these schools.

You must apply before the deadline date of the 15 January 2021.



Making an application

Wirral's online admission system can be accessed from www.wirral.gov.uk/
schooladmissions. Applying online is quick and simple to do. You will receive an automatic email so that you know your application has been received by us. In April 2021, online applicants will receive an email with their child's allocated place. The deadline for online applications to be submitted is 15 January 2021.

- You can put up to three schools in the order of your preference. It is always recommended to put more than one school
- All Wirral primary or infant schools can be included as preferences, except for private schools.
- We recommend you include your zone school as one of your preferences. The Wirral primary school Catchment Area finder is available at www.wirral.gov.uk/ schooladmissions or call 0151 606 2020 for assistance.
- You can include schools outside Wirral in your preferences if you want.
- Attending a school nursery class or having other children already attending the school does not guarantee a place in Foundation 2 You must complete an application form by the deadline.

- If you are applying for a Catholic or Church of England Aided school you may also need to fill in a supplementary form. You must ask the school yourself to find out what their arrangements are.
- If you live in another part of England, you must apply through your home authority.

If you cannot apply online, you can complete a paper application form. In April 2021 you will receive an allocation letter by post to your home address. The Mainstream Admissions team cannot send an allocation email to you unless you apply online.

If you have applied on a paper form, the Mainstream Admissions team will acknowledge receipt of your application within 15 working days. If you have not received an acknowledgement after this time, please email **primaryplaces@wirral.gov.uk**. Note that the Mainstream Admissions team will not acknowledge paper form applications received after the deadline for paper applications which is **15 January 2021**.

Allocation of places

Every child is given a rank for every school preference based on the admission policy for the school. If your child is eligible to be given a Foundation 2 place at more than one school, you will be offered a place at the school you have named as the highest preference. If it is not possible to offer a child a place at any of your preferences you will be given a place at the nearest appropriate school with a place available.

Online applicants will receive an e-mail offer of a place on 16 April 2021. Offers of places to parents who applied on a paper form will be posted second class on that day. Late applications received after 15 January 2021 are only dealt with AFTER places have been offered to parents who have applied on time
